**COVID precautions:**

Mask Requirements in Worship

As members of a beloved church community, we have the responsibility of self-care and are accountable for caring for one another. Anyone with symptoms of viral infection, positive covid test, or Covid exposure should refrain from attending church services or gatherings.

- High quality face masks (3-ply medical, KN95 or N95) are required for everyone 3 years and older.
- Adult masks and children's masks will be provided by the church.
- Presenters are allowed to remove masks while speaking.
- Choir will wear masks while singing.
  - A soloist or group of four or less may sing while unmasked, distancing as much as space allows.

Vaccination

OBUUC strongly encourages all to be fully vaccinated as their age and personal situation allow. Full Covid 19 vaccination is required for staff.

Food and Drink

Due to the mask requirement. There is no food or drink in the sanctuary.

Gatherings Outside of Worship

Masks are highly encouraged but not required at OBUUC gatherings that are not worship. Food and drinks may be shared in George Bray hall. Please schedule use of George Bray hall with the congregational administrator.

RE Protocols for George Bray Hall

High quality masks (3 ply medical, KN95 or N95) are required in the church building during worship services for anyone 3 or older. Cloth masks are not allowed.

Child sized high quality masks will be provided if needed.

To improve air circulation a fan will be running in George Bray Hall. HEPA Air filters will be placed in the nursery, the classroom near the elevator, and the main area of George Bray Hall.

As part of our registration form parents have the opportunity to decide if they are ok with their children eating in the large group (masks off to eat) or if they want their children to eat in a family group away from the others
